





CHÂTEAU BOISSON

Château Boisson is a stunning estate located at the gateway of Cadillac in the small municipality of Beguey. Overlooking the Garonne River, the vineyard is nestled at the top of a hill above ancient stone quarries.

The domain covers about 12 hectares of very old vines where white and red grape varieties evenly share the clay-siliceous soil.



Grape varieties

80% Merlot 20% Cabernet Sauvignon

Age of the vineyard - Area 15-20 years - 12 hectares



Soils

Clay-siliceous soil originating from the erosion of the hillsides

Vinification

After destemming, grapes are put to tanks for fermentation under temperature control. This process lasts for between 15 to 18 days. After racking, wines are blended, and then aged in wooden barrels underground for 12 months
